## Each winter, dogs left outdoors suffer frostbite or freeze to death

If you see a pet left outside with inadequate shelter, politely let the owner know you're concerned. Some people don't realize that their pets are vulnerable to cold weather. Even thick-coated breeds need insulated shelter protected from snow and wind.

If you fear for the animal's safety, note the date, time, location and type of animal and take video or photo evidence. Report the information to your local animal care and control agency or police department. Follow up respectfully with the agency if necessary. Together, we can make sure pets don't feel the chill this winter.
